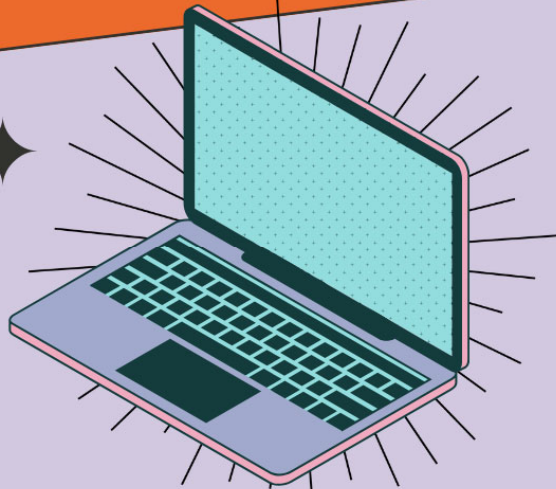

## Youth Diversion

On August 5, DYD highlighted a landmark evaluation of the County's [Youth Diversion and Development Program](#) during a round table discussion with Board Chair Lindsey P. Horvath, Sheriff Luna, Olivia Shields, and Jaazaniah Augustus!

Chair Horvath urged continued collaboration to expand access to the program to youth across the County. "Youth diversion from the justice system is not only the right thing to do, but the smart thing to do," said Chair Horvath. "As Los Angeles County accelerates our commitment to Youth Justice Reimagined, supporting our Department of Youth Development, and bringing community partners together to engage in discussions like today's, is critical. Our young people deserve our full attention and investment through diversion, which will make all of our communities safer and healthier."

## Youth Reentry

The Probation Department has released a new clearance policy for staff and community-based organizations providing services in all secure probation facilities. This policy establishes a consistent and more transparent standard for all individuals, including those with lived experience of justice system involvement, to work in these facilities to support youth. DYD worked closely with Probation and other partners to provide feedback on the policy and provide edits that made the policy more evidence-informed and inclusive.

DYD has long been working with Probation on the clearance of Credible Messengers awaiting clearance and admission to facilities to provide mentoring, programming, and support to youth. Many of the Credible Messengers who were previously denied clearance have now been approved, allowing nearly a dozen mentors to support youth across various facilities in Los Angeles County.

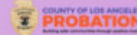
